- Valid First-aid/CPR certification

- Experience in live-in and/or international camp situations (preferred)

Specific Duties & Responsibilities

- Ensure health and safety of campers
- Supervising meals, free time in residence and all activities
- Accompanying campers to afternoon and evening activities
- Be on site 24 hours a day during camp schedule
- Participate in activities as a role model of appropriate enthusiasm and social skills
- Ensure bed-time and wake-up are on time
- Ensure campers are abiding by residence rules and regulations
- Attends to camper concerns
